SPOILED ROTTEN bumped with a rival at the start, contested the pace, vied two to three wide on the turn, inched clear passing the quarter-pole and drew off under strong urging. NAFISS bumped with a rival at the start, chased the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn and earned the place while no match for the winner. POCKET MONEY was urged along while off the pace, dropped back while erratic leaving the backstretch, raced off the rail on the turn and was best of the rest. COUNTY SLIP bumped with a rival after the start, was urged along while off the pace, raced four to five wide on the turn and tired. GIVEN TRAPP was urged along while off the pace, raced four then three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. BOSS M was urged along while off the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn and came up empty. GEORGE A. pressed the pace on the inside, dropped back near the seven-sixteenths pole, continued to drop back while inside on the turn and had nothing left. BRICK MAKER lunged a bit at the start but broke with the field, contested the pace, vied inside on the turn and gave way.
