MARKET'S BEST tracked the pace through the final turn, made a bid in upper stretch, took the lead passing the furlong marker, and edged away under hand urging. PEACEFUL PLACE set all of the pace, was headed passing the furlong marker, and was outfinished late. CHASE A STAR was well placed from the start, saved ground throughout, ranged up on the final turn, posed a threat entering the stretch, but came up empty. STORMY HOUR raced well back in the field, saved ground into the stretch, and never reached contention. HEATHER ANN raced well back in the field, and showed little. TOUR'S ENERGY raced up close to the pace, was through after a half, and faded. BURNIN' MEMORIES was always outrun.
