ROCKS AND RINGS was well placed on the inside, moved out on the far turn, rallied four wide into the stretch, closed strongly to get the lead passing the furlong marker, drifted out a bit shortly thereafter and edged clear under good handling. MISS PISQUALIE broke a bit slow, raced four wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, chased three to four wide on the far turn, moved to five wide near the quarter-pole, loomed a threat into the final furlong but proved no match for the winner. LIL' ELLIE crossed over entering the first turn, set the clear pace, lost the lead near the furlong marker and weakened while just able to hold the show. CASSENA raced three wide on the first turn, settled in the second flight, moved closer near the three-eighths pole, chased three wide on the far turn and also weakened. TSALAGI was in tight at the start, lagged well back in the field, raced four wide on the far turn and failed to rally. TRICKY ETBAUER raced in the second flight, chased the leader on the far turn and tired. SPRING OF LIFE broke outward at the start, settled on the inside, saved ground into the stretch and failed to respond. LIKE MY DAD broke a bit slow, lingered at the rear and was no factor. WISEMAN'S LADY broke outward at the start, settled towards the rear and also failed to respond. (Rail at 20 Feet)
