JULIANS STORM bumped with a rival at the start, set the pace while off the rail, edged clear on the turn, responded well in the stretch and held under strong urging. PERFECTLY WICKED pressed the pace, dropped back on the turn, was roused at the top of the stretch and closed determinedly but failed to reach the winner. DEVILOUSLY FAST broke a bit slow, was ridden along while off the pace, advanced three to four wide on the turn, loomed a threat into the final furlong but weakened and settled for the show. K D CHEYENNE broke outward and bumped with a rival, chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn, dropped to one off the rail near the quarter-pole and came up empty. SWEETSWEETRAMONA dropped well behind the field, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to threaten. GRAND OPRY pressed the pace on the inside, dropped back on the turn and retreated.
