**Footnotes**

F P ELECTRIC STORM veered in at the start and bumped with a rival, chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn, battled determinedly in the stretch and wore down the leader late under steady urging. I KNOW JOE set the pace, held a clear lead into the final furlong but was caught. B G GOLDEN TIME bobbed at the start then was bumped on both sides and taken up, was in tight off heels near the half-mile pole, raced four to five wide on the turn and finished willingly for the show. COOKIE DOUGH hopped at the start and was off slow, moved up on the outside while ridden along and finished willingly but missed the show. Z CAT PARADE was urged along in the middle of the field and failed to rally. JUSTONEOFTHEGIRLS saved ground at the rear of the field and was no factor. STORMY SENSATION was ridden along near the inside, saved ground on the turn and failed to respond. JETTIN WAGON raced towards the rear of the field, went three then four wide on the turn and was no factor. JOSLYN STREET was bumped at the start and forced into a rival, raced well back in the field, went five then four wide on the turn and never reached contention. INDIAN AFFAIRS chased the pace, went wrong midway through the turn and was pulled up then vanned off.
