FASTEN UP came in early, chased then pressed the pace, took the lead at the top of the stretch, edged clear outside the furlong marker and held while tired late. VENOM came in a bit at the start, chased the pace, saved ground on the turn, moved out in the stretch and finished willingly for the place. DEL RIO was hustled to the lead, set the pace, lost the lead at the top of the stretch and was outfinished while well clear for the show. DOUBLEUPTOCATCHUP bobbled after the start, raced well back in the field, swung out at the top of the stretch and failed to threaten. SMILE TWO was ridden along while off the pace, came four wide into the stretch and failed to respond. UNBRIDLED CHIEF was in tight after the start, saved ground near the back of the field and was no factor. HATORI was bumped in the hindquarters at the start, raced well back in the field, went three wide early on the turn then dropped to one off the rail and showed little. SR. MANUEL broke inward at the start, was carried in by the winner early, raced towards the front while ridden along, went three wide on the turn and came up empty. RESERVED FOR GOLD broke inward and bumped with a rival then was taken up, raced well back in the field, came three wide into the stretch and never reached contention.
