AVA MAE was well placed while on the inside, chased the leaders on the far turn, came off the rail at the top of the stretch, rallied on the outside and closed well to get up late. I'M A BAD GIRL contested the pace on the inside, inched clear when set down at the top of the stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was caught. MISS PEPPER brushed with a rival at the start, raced off the rail on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while inside on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and finished willingly for the show. CHECK MY HALO NAU was unhurried at the rear while saving ground, came under urging on the far turn, was put to the whip at the top of the stretch and finished willingly but missed the show. PURE RED HEAD settled on the outside, was urged along on the far turn, came three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed kick. LET'S DREAM AGAIN brushed with a rival at the start, moved up while eager and under a tight hold, raced three wide on the first turn, contested the pace on the outside, vied three wide on the far turn and gave way.
