Footnotes

GOOD OLD BORTZ was urged along while off the pace, moved out on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, took the lead near the three-sixteenths pole, battled with OUR COUNTRY in the final furlong and prevailed under steady urging. OUR COUNTRY broke outward at the start, chased the pace on the outside, raced four then three wide on the turn, took a short lead passing the furlong marker, lost the lead in upper stretch and was outfinished while able to secure the place. TRULY GONE WILD was ridden along while off the pace, raced three then four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and finished willingly for the show. JETT CITY chased the pace, raced three wide on the turn and tired. HE'S A POWER STORM broke in a bit, moved to the lead and set the pace, lost the lead passing the quarter-pole and gave way. MOUNTAIN GEM moved up while urged along, saved ground on the turn and came up empty. BOLD SPIKE chased the pace, drifted three wide near the quarter-pole and faded.
