SHOOT IT'S WAR bumped with a rival at the start, tracked the pace, gained the lead near the seven-sixteenths pole, edged clear on the far turn, responded well when threatened by APRIL'S PICTURE in upper stretch and proved best under strong urging. APRIL'S PICTURE settled off the pace, rallied on the far turn, loomed a threat into the final furlong but was turned away and settled for the place. STORMY LYPARD settled on the inside, saved ground into the stretch and came up empty while best of the rest. STREET POSITIONING broke inward and bumped with a rival, was unhurried towards the rear and lacked the needed response. DO YOU SEE ME NOW broke outward and bumped with a rival, settled off the pace, was carried four to five wide on the far turn and failed to respond. DANCE ALL THE WAY was bumped on both sides at the start, settled on the outside, was carried five to six wide on the far turn and came up empty. YONAFRENCH brushed with a rival at the start, lugged out while setting the pace on the first turn, relinquished the lead near the seven-sixteenths pole, lugged out on the far turn and dropped out. (Rail at 10 Feet)
