FIREBALL'S ACE bumped with a rival at the start, dueled on the outside, inched clear passing the quarter-pole and drew off while ridden out. MOONCOIN CAT veered out at the start, was ridden along on the outside, raced three to four wide on the turn and got up for the place. CAPTNROBBY'S APPEAL chased the pace, came three wide into the stretch and weakened. WHOS THE LEGEND dueled on the inside, dropped out near the quarter-pole and gave way. SAINTLY SPECIAL broke a bit awkwardly, was ridden along while off the pace and came up empty. ARCTIC FRONT was off slow, raced well back in the field, came three wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. PRESTAMOS DINERO was ridden along while just off the pace, chased three to four wide on the turn and faded. POLISH LEOPARDO ducked in at the start and was off slow, moved up while ridden along, came up empty while saving ground on the turn and retreated. CONFIRM FLIER bumped with a rival at the start, dropped to the rear of the field and was no factor.
