SASSY BADGER went three then two wide on the first turn, contested the pace on the outside, moved clear with three furlongs to run, drew off on the far turn, was put to the whip in upper stretch, opened a commanding lead into the final furlong and held while exhausted late under strong urging. ROYAL CHA CHA saved ground on the first turn, lagged at the rear while under some urging, raced inside on the far turn, shifted off the rail at the top of the stretch, gained on the tired winner in the final furlong and secured the place. GLORIOUS DEVON came away well then was asked, raced off the rail early on the first turn then dropped to the inside, disputed the pace on the inside of the winner, dropped back near the three-eighths pole, chased inside on the far turn, gained on the winner in the final furlong and earned the show. COOKIN GONE BAD went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and failed to rally. SASSY N SPECIAL settled off the pace, was ridden along while off the rail on the far turn and faltered.
