PROMISE OF WAR reserved near the back in the early going, moved up racing five wide around the final turn, finished fast, going away at the end. KIPLING void of early speed, made a late wide bid, clearly second. PRIVATE POWER unhurried in the beginning, gained ground. PIRANHURST raced closer to the back in the beginning, made a late rally. COLONIAL POWER raced in the middle of the field, came around the final turn on the outside and finished evenly. PERSONAL PARADE raced in the middle of the pack, lacked a late rally. RIVETER raced behind the leaders in the beginning, finished early. ST. CROIX opened up on the field, tired. STAR OF ERIN raced behind the top two in the early going, checked in the final turn, getting in tight on the rail, dropped back and never recovered. SHEIKH CANDOU followed the leader in the early part, stopped.
