Footnotes

STORMY DATE dueled between rivals, battled gamely in the stretch and prevailed under strong urging. VALARS pressed the pace, vied three wide on the turn, dueled in the stretch and missed. SPARK PLUG was well placed just off the pace, saved ground on the turn, was blocked from the three-sixteenths pole to inside the eighth-pole, moved in a bit shortly thereafter and finished willingly but lost his best chance. SNOOKY'S IMAGE stalked the pace on the outside, chased four wide on the turn, held a good striking position into the final furlong but was outfinished. CACTUSBUD dueled on the inside, vied into the final furlong and weakened. PRIMED PIONEER was urged along near the back of the compact field, shifted in near the half-mile pole, raced off the rail on the turn and failed to respond. U CAN BANK ON IT raced on the inside of ROCKIN' RONNY, lugged in while four then three wide on the turn, continued to lug inward in upper stretch and faltered. JADACUS FAST GOLD broke a bit slow, was ridden along at the back of the field, raced three then four wide on the turn and also failed to respond. ROCKIN' RONNY settled on the outside, raced four to five wide on the turn and came up empty.
