Footnotes

WILD FOR WHO bumped lightly with a rival at the start, showed good speed then shook clear, dictated terms through the turn, extended the advantage under a drive in upper stretch and held under steady handling. PAID VACATION bumped lightly with an opponent at the start, was urged along while just off the pace, raced inside on the turn, came out in upper stretch and finished willingly for the place. BOBBIE DAN was ridden along while off the pace, went three to four wide on the turn and was best of the rest. IT GETS BETTER chased the pace on the inside of a rival, went three then two wide on the turn and tired. LOUISE'S DEAL chased the pace on the outside, raced four then three wide on the turn and weakened. DEFIANT LADY was hard ridden at the rear, raced off the rail early on the turn, shifted five wide near the quarter-pole and failed to threaten. ILA'S SERENITY was reluctant to load, dropped off the pace while urged along and failed to respond. ANA'S DANDY chased the early pace then dropped back, went two to three wide on the turn and retreated.
