GOLDEN RHYTHM was allowed to settle, angled four wide entering the stretch, and closed strongly. BIEN NICOLE tracked the pace while three wide, made a bid leaving the turn, but was outfinished. DANCE MEMORIES was reserved off the pace, advanced on the final turn, and closed moderately in the stretch. WOLFNIK was unhurried in mid pack, raced four wide on the final turn, swung five wide into the stretch, and went evenly. ASHEVILLE set the pace into the stretch, was collared outside the furlong marker, and gave way. WILD SQUAW was well placed while saving ground, made a bid on the rail entering the stretch, but faltered. RUSH THE RANSOM hopped at the start, raced near the back, went four wide on the final turn, and failed to threaten. COMPANY STORM crossed over leaving the chute, pressed the pace into the stretch, and faded in a dull effort. BONUS BID saved ground to no avail.
