GARCIA'S LETTER showed good speed and set the pace, vied between rivals on the turn, dueled with BIG TONY in the stretch and prevailed under strong urging. BIG TONY pressed the pace on the inside, dueled on the turn, battled with GARCIA'S LETTER in the stretch and was outfinished while well clear for the place. WAR WHOOP was void of speed, raced off the rail on the turn, came three wide into the stretch and got up for the show. EVE N TOUCH pressed the pace on the outside, dueled three wide on the turn and tired. EL D broke out and a bit slow, was urged along on the outside, raced four to five wide on the turn and failed to threaten. SHINING VALUE settled off the pace, was urged along while off the rail on the turn and came up empty. DANCE ALL THE WAY raced well back in the field, saved ground on the turn and was outrun. DOWNS AWARENESS raced towards the rear of the field, went four to five wide on the turn and was no factor. DOT'S TWO SOCKS settled off the pace, was urged along while three to four wide on the turn and retreated.
