Footnotes

TED THE PROTECTOR was urged along at the rear of the field, raced inside on the turn, cut the corner into the stretch, gained ground into the final furlong, angled out inside the eighth-pole and closed fast to get up at the wire. BRICK MAKER was forced out early then taken up, settled off the pace, was urged along while inside on the turn, swung three wide into the stretch, chased the leader on the outside, gained the advantage near the sixteenth-pole but was denied at the wire. STRATEGIC PLAYER set the pace under pressure, vied inside on the turn, came under the whip in upper stretch, lost the lead passing the sixteenth-pole and was outfinished while able to get the show. JOHNNY'S SLICE came out some early, pressed the pace on the inside of a rival, chased while off the rail on the turn, pursued the leader into the final furlong, held a good striking position but weakened. SLEW LUNA was forced out early, settled off the pace, raced off the rail early on the turn, shifted four wide near the quarter-pole and failed to threaten. EL BRONCO pressed the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the turn, floated four wide into the stretch and tired. LONESOME WHO was restless in the gate, raced in fourth position while urged along, went two to three wide on the turn and came up empty.
