**Footnotes**

MORE TO THE STORY brushed with a rival at the start, was well rated while off the rail, responded well when set down near the furlong marker and held sway under right hand urging. THE DIFFERENCE brushed with a rival at the start, settled off the pace, shifted four wide midway through the turn, rallied in upper stretch and closed well but missed. ADVISABLE settled off the pace, moved out while advancing midway down the backstretch, chased three wide on the far turn and weakened while clear for the show. RICH PEARL tracked the pace on the inside, chased inside on the far turn and came up empty. WINDY'S BLAZER raced three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and failed to respond. RIXA MARIE tracked the pace, was hard ridden on the far turn and faded. HENERITA MYSTERY raced four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while three to four wide on the far turn and also failed to respond. MS SULTRY was very rank into the first turn then swerved out, raced towards the rear of the field and faltered. CHECK MY HALO NAU was forced six wide early on the first turn and never reached contention.
