IDREAMOFAFRICA lingered well back in the field, rallied on the far turn, made a three wide bid at the top of the stretch, battled with TREADING WATER while on the outside and prevailed under strong urging. TREADING WATER followed the clear leader from second, advanced on the far turn, made a bid passing the quarter-pole, battled with IDREAMOFAFRICA in the stretch and missed. SHE'SAMARK raced three then two wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the spread-out field, advanced inside on the far turn, came off the rail near the quarter-pole, moved out in upper stretch and finished willingly to get the show. GIRLSFEST raced three wide on the first turn, lagged at the rear of the field, moved closer while three wide early on the far turn, shifted five wide near the quarter-pole and improved position. G G'S GIRL raced four then three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn and failed to rally. RESTLESS STAR broke out at the start then was hustled, set the clear pace, lost the lead just inside the quarter-pole and tired. SWEET TEXAS STAR was hustled from the start, raced off the rail on the first turn, was urged along on the backstretch and faltered.
