NO REGRET came out at the start, was urged along on the outside, rallied four wide on the turn, took the lead at the top of the stretch, drew clear under strong urging and proved much the best. HELLO BUD raced well back in the field, shifted four wide near the quarter-pole and finished willingly for the place. WHY BILL WHY moved in while off the pace, saved ground on the turn, shifted out in upper stretch and lacked the needed response while able to get the show. ANDREW'S ALLOWANCE was void of speed, raced three then four wide early on the turn, moved to six wide near the quarter-pole, came seven wide into the stretch and improved position. MILES ABLAZE moved up to contest the pace, shook clear near the half-mile mole, controlled the action on the turn, lost the lead at the top of the stretch and gave way. MATAMBRE was ridden along in the middle of the field, raced three wide on the turn and failed to rally. COSTAMUCHO was ridden along while off the pace, raced four then five wide on the turn, moved in a bit at the top of the stretch and failed to threaten. SPEECH broke out at the start, chased the pace on the outside then three wide on the turn and tired. SEBASTION showed good speed, contested the pace, chased on the turn and faded. SAND DUSTY chased the pace, raced off the rail on the turn and stopped.
