BIDDY LULU settled at the rear of the field, allowed the rest of the field to dispute the pace, went three to four wide on the turn, rallied to the lead in upper stretch and drew away then was eased up in the final sixteenth. BRIDAL TRAIN pressed the pace on the outside, vied five wide early on the turn, dropped to three wide while inching clear near the quarter-pole, lost touch with the winner near the furlong marker and proved no match while clear for the place. G J'S PRIDE pressed the pace between rivals, came under strong urging near the half-mile pole, vied four then three wide on the turn and tired while able to get the show. BLOOMTOWN BABY disputed the pace between rivals, dropped back near the five-sixteenths pole, shifted four wide in the vicinity of the quarter-pole and tired. LOLLY GOGGIN moved up after the start, contested the pace between rivals, vied three wide early on the turn then dropped in some, chased into the stretch and gave way. BREAKFORTHEFINISH moved up to contest the pace on the inside, dropped back near the five-sixteenths pole and came up empty.
