PRINCE BLAKE was caught five wide into the first turn, dropped to four wide nearing the six-furlong marker, tracked the pace on the outside, engaged the leaders near the half-mile marker, kicked clear leaving the far turn and proved much the best under steady handling. THE PRIDE OF DIXIE broke outward and bumped with a rival, settled between rivals, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and earned the place while no match for the winner. TANZALASKA set the pace under steady pressure, vied into the stretch and weakened. LIGHT THE DAWN raced third wide on the first turn, pressed the pace on the outside, dropped back near the seven-sixteenths marker, chased while off the rail on the far turn and tired. RICKLES was reserved towards the rear of the field while off the rail, lacked the needed response when asked and failed to rally. CHIPS AND BEER was caught four wide early on the first turn, dropped in midway through that turn, settled near the back of the field while off the rail and failed to threaten. CLEM DA CLAIMER was hard held while three wide on the first turn, settled a bit on the backstretch, was ridden along while three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch and never reached contention. ENSIGN JAKE was bumped at the start, raced four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was ridden along while four wide on the far turn and came up empty. HE WILL lagged behind the field, raced three wide on the second turn and showed little. I SELL FIRE settled on the inside, came up empty on the far turn and dropped out. JUNCTION JIMMY went four to five wide on the first turn, was unhurried towards the rear of the field, raced four wide on the second turn and was outrun. MAX AMILLIONAIR was well placed on the inside, came up empty on the far turn and retreated.
