Footnotes

EARLY DUSK dueled between rivals, battled gamely in the stretch and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. JONESICULA dueled on the inside, battled gamely in the stretch and just missed. SERGEANT SAXTON chased the pace on the outside, engaged the leaders while four wide on the turn, dueled in the stretch and was outfinished while able to get the show. DECANter dueled between rivals, vied three wide on the turn, battled between rivals in the stretch and was outfinished late then missed the show. EDPLICIT was ridden along while off the pace, raced three then four wide on the turn, brushed with H. C. MYSTERY while five wide entering the stretch and failed to rally. MEXICAN STORM chased the leaders through the turn and tired. STADT MEISTER dropped off the pace, saved ground on the turn and failed to respond. H. C. MYSTERY was ridden along on the outside, raced four to five wide on the turn, brushed with EDPLICIT while six wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. COOPERS GULCH was ridden along in the middle of the field, floated four wide into the stretch and had nothing left. SHADOW'S BABY was urged along near the back, raced near the rail on the turn and showed little.
