ARGENTINA AVENUE vied for the lead from the beginning, took the advantage around the turn, pulled away, finished well. WADIF lacked early speed, came around the turn wide and made a late gain. BRIEF VALENTINE got off to a slow start, rushed up on the inside, vied for the lead, tired late. AUTO BE A PRO within contention, moved up on the inside around the turn, flattened out. MRSKNOWITALL evenly near the back. WALLENA within striking distance, dropped back, bled. SHEER BLISS stumbled at the start, never close. GUATEMALA (MEX) pressed pace, stopped.
