SPRING RUSH quickly assumed command, responded when challenged entering the stretch, and drew off while kept to task. COLEE BEAR chased the pace on the inside, saved ground into the stretch, and gained mildly. YOU GLITTER GIRL tracked the pace, made a bid leaving the turn, but weakened in the final furlong. DAYLIGHT ROBBERY was never far back, failed to rally, and went evenly throughout. STIRRIN UP A STORM stumbled badly at the start, made a bold middle move while four wide on the turn, came in and bumped with CASTELLI'S GYPSY in upper stretch, and flattened out in the final furlong. CASTELLI'S GYPSY raced in mid pack, bumped with STIRRIN UP A STORM in upper stretch, and went evenly in the final furlong. THIRTY LUV was ridden along to be near mid pack, and failed to menace. LOVENIA broke outward a bit at the start, and was always outrun. JAZZY TIMES was reluctant to load and was fractious in the gate, raced up close early, got shuffled back near the three-eighths pole, and faded. DERBY ANGEL veered out at the start, and never reached contention.
