COZY LASS was well placed through the final turn, angled out entering the stretch, closed strongly and was ridden out. EGYPTIAN EYES was allowed to settle, ranged up on the far turn, steadied off heels entering the stretch, angled in near the furlong marker, and finished well while no impact to the winner. COZY SUSIE stalked the pace, made a bid midway through the final turn, vied past the eighth pole, and lacked the needed response late. MARFA'S TAXES raced in mid pack, went four wide on the second turn, and finished willingly in the stretch. MANZOTTINA raced near mid field, ranged up five wide on the final turn, loomed a threat into the final furlong, but flattened out late. ALLEGEDLY IRISH was always outrun. WHISKEY TANGO set a measured pace, was collared in upper stretch, and faded. MYBRINAJILL raced up close, steadied near the five-sixteenth pole, and dropped out.
