Footnotes

SILVER FLICKA drifted out early, tracked the pace, raced three wide on the turn, dropped to one off the rail and made a bid passing the quarter-pole, inched clear into the final furlong, was headed late but gamely prevailed. WANNABEAROCKSTAR bumped with a rival at the start, chased the pace, was blocked from the quarter-pole to the three-sixteenths pole, rallied between rivals entering the final furlong, closed well to gain the slimmest of leads late but was denied. BIG CEE broke inward at the start, was hard ridden along while off the pace, raced three to four wide on the turn and earned the show while no match for the top two. OH SHINE broke inward at the start, was carried out early, chased four then three wide on the turn and came up empty. CAT GONE WILD broke inward and bumped with a rival, moved up to take the lead, set the pace under some pressure, vied into the stretch and gave way. B G GIFT EXCHANGE was hustled from the start, chased on the inside, saved ground on the turn and faded. SMOOTHING IRON broke inward at the start then dropped back, raced well off the pace, moved out leaving the backstretch, went four to five wide on the turn and failed to respond.
