Footnotes

SCRAPPY ROO was rated just off the pace, waited behind the leaders from the quarter-pole to the eighth-pole, rallied between rivals outside the sixteenth-pole, closed fast to take the lead then surged clear under strong hand urging. WINCHESTER BAY was well rated while setting the pace, responded well in the stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was overtaken while clear for the place. HOW'S THAT hopped slightly at the start, prompted the pace on the outside while under a tight hold, vied outside on the far turn, battled into the final furlong and weakened. LEALLAH'S ANTHONY settled on the inside, saved ground into the stretch and failed to rally. EDLOS TWIST settled off the pace, saved ground on the far turn and also failed to rally. GROOM'S CAT broke out a bit at the start, raced well back in the field, came three wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. TEXAS TYCOON broke out a bit at the start, raced four wide on the first turn, settled near the back, was urged along while three wide on the far turn and failed to menace. SHAKE A LAKE broke out a bit at the start, raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside and failed to respond. (Rail at 20 Feet)
