KRISTYS XPECTATION showed good speed, dueled on the inside, battled gamely in the stretch and narrowly prevailed under strong urging. DONEGAL GOLD moved up to duel for the lead, battled gamely with the winner in the stretch and just missed. THE SMART LOOK broke out at the start, settled off the pace, was urged along on the turn, came under an all out drive in upper stretch, drifted out late and finished willingly for the show. LUCKENBACH MOON chased the dueling leaders, raced off the rail on the turn, moved out once straightened for the drive and lacked the needed kick. STACKEDNDELIVERED settled at the rear of the field, was urged along while off the rail on the turn and failed to rally. HEARTSCORE dueled on the outside, vied three to four wide on the turn and tired. (Rail at 20 Feet)
