### Footnotes

TOMAHAWK CREEK veered in at the start and broke a bit slow, dueled on the inside, kicked clear at the top of the stretch and held well under strong urging. MY STAR RUNNER settled off the pace, raced near the inside on the turn, was asked at the top of the stretch and was second best. PACIFIC TSUNAMI was urged along while off the pace, raced three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and got up for the show. RANGER DANGER dueled on the outside, chased three wide on the turn and tired. KISSIN CHILD lacked early speed, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. FUTURE COVENANT dueled between rivals then outside on the turn and gave way. (Rail at 20 Feet)
