SASSY SANDY was off a tad slow, steadied when squeezed shortly after the start, lagged near the back, rallied four wide entering the stretch, and closed very fast to get up in the final strides. TOOK OUT settled while saving ground, ranged up four wide on the final turn, and closed steadily to just miss. TIFF'S BONZAI was unhurried early, made a bid three wide entering the stretch, and also closed steadily. CRAFTY TAYLOR set a clear pace, remained well clear into deep stretch, but was caught late and denied. UNRAVEL tracked the pace, made a mild bid leaving the far turn, but came up empty. APPROVEDENGAGEMENT raced near mid pack, and failed to rally in an even effort. WILDCAT'S BABE raced well back in the field, and never reached contention. FEDERAL CASE checked near the seven-eighths pole, trailed the field into the stretch, and failed to threaten. LA PRYOR STAR was reserved off the pace, raced five wide on the final turn, and was no factor. SUNRISE MISS was away awkwardly at the start, raced well placed into the final turn, but faded steadily thereafter.
