Footnotes

NATURALLY WILD settled while saving ground, ranged up near the five-sixteenths marker, collared AUTOBESARAH just inside the furlong marker, and proved best under strong handling. GOLDEN RHYTHM was allowed to settle into stride, ranged up on the final turn, rallied at the top of the stretch, closed well into the final sixteenth, but couldn't reach the winner. AUTOBESARAH stalked the pace through the backstretch, took the lead entering the final turn, inched clear into the stretch, was collared just inside the furlong marker, and gave way. DISTANT VALLEY (GB) was unhurried at the back, roused passing the quarter pole, but lacked the needed rally. DUE TO WIN raced near the middle of the field, and failed to rally. MYBRINAJILL contested the pace on the inside, was through after a half mile, and stopped. ANNIE'S HONOR set the pace down the backstretch, was headed entering the second turn, and retreated. TOTALLY CRAFTY was always outrun. PLEASANT STATE raced in the middle of the field, was roused passing the half mile marker, but failed to respond.
