TAKE THE BLAME was urged along between rivals on the backstretch, vied three wide while still between rivals on the turn, came four wide into the stretch, and closed strongly to get up late. SIENNA'S HONOR pressed the pace while three wide, took the lead in upper stretch, edged clear into the final furlong, and was caught late. SITA RAM was off a bit slowly, advanced on the inside to race just behind the leaders, saved ground on the turn, and finished willingly for third in a good effort. HALEY'S SHARP was bumped hard at the start, settled between rivals on the backstretch, jostled with STAR'S KANDI KANE entering the turn, dropped out while four wide near the three-eighths pole, floated five wide near the quarter-pole, and lacked the needed response. J T'S PRINCES set the pace under pressure, was headed in upper stretch, and faded. MONTREAL PRINCESS was hard held between rivals, dropped out leaving the turn, and gave way. STAR'S KANDI KANE broke inward and bobbed at the start, then bumped with HALEY'S SHARP and was taken up, jostled with that rival while five wide leaving the backstretch, vied four wide on the turn, and had nothing left.
