AMERICAN RASCAL bumped with a rival at the start, was urged along while off the pace, rallied five wide into the stretch, closed well to get the lead near the furlong marker then edged clear under strong urging. CITY FLEET broke inward and bumped with a rival, chased the pace, made a bid leaving the backstretch, dueled on the turn and weakened while able to get the place. BULLETT BLAKE was urged along while just off the pace, shifted four wide to make a bid near the quarter-pole, vied into the final furlong and also weakened. TRAFFIC COMMAND moved up on the outside, vied three wide on the turn, steadied near the sixteenth-pole and gave way. WISHINSKI brushed with a rival at the start, settled off the pace, was roused near the quarter-pole, came three wide into the stretch and failed to rally. SYN RIVER bumped with a rival at the start, settled off the pace, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten while under moderate encouragement. TEXAS TALL TALE bumped with a rival at the start, set the pace, vied inside on the turn and tired. MALABAR SLEW stumbled at the start, raced well back in the field and trailed.
