SCREEN ATTRACTION unhurried in the beginning, angled to the inside around the final turn, made a late bid entering the home stretch, took command and was going away at the end. FEELING SASSY vied for the early advantage, racing on the inside, forwardly placed throughout, but was no match for the winner, clearly second. DYNATTACK vied for the early lead, raced on the rail down the backside, finished evenly behind the top two. TALL GAL broke slow, racing near the back, saved ground around the final turn and lacked a late rally. GONE GREEN dueled for the early advantage, done early. SNEAKY KISS saved ground, racing in the middle of the pack in the early going, finished early and was never a factor. SPELL AGAIN always raced near the back and was no threat. COMBAT CUTIE raced within contention, outside around both turns, then dropped back. DUKE'S LUCK hesitated, then hopped out, trailed throughout.
