Footnotes

MISS BRIDGET JONES dueled on the outside of LETITHAPPENCAPTAIN, shook off that rival at the top of the stretch, and drew away under steady right hand urging. SOURIS was reserved at the back of the field, rallied four wide leaving the turn, and finished well. CITY SLEEPER bumped with SISTERLITA near the five-eighths pole, was allowed to settle into stride, advanced four wide on the turn, and finished willingly while lacking the needed response. ETERNAL CUP bobbed at the start, stalked the dueling leaders, was well placed into the stretch, but came up empty when called upon. LETITHAPPENCAPTAIN broke outward and bumped with VALID PULPIT, recovered and moved up to contest the lead, dueled on the inside of MISS BRIDGET JONES, lost touch with that rival in upper stretch, and weakened. LADY MALLORY was bumped after the start, raced well back in the field, and passed tired rivals in the stretch. FABULOUS BRUSH raced in the middle of the pack, was in tight near the three furlong marker, and failed to threaten. REAL BEAR was in tight at the start, raced towards the rear of the field, and showed little in a dull effort. SISTERLITA bumped with rivals after the start, bumped with CITY SLEEPER near the five furlong marker, was ridden along to be up close, and faded. SCOTTISH HERITAGE bobbed at the start then drifted out, raced well off the pace, went four wide on the turn, and was always outrun. VALID PULPIT was bumped at the start, raced near mid pack on the inside, and stopped after running a half mile.
