CLOCK settled on the inside, moved out on the far turn, rallied three wide into the stretch, closed well to make a bid passing the eighth-pole, battled determinedly in the final furlong and narrowly prevailed under right hand urging. CATRIN was rated just off the pace, waited while saving ground on the far turn, was blocked from the quarter-pole into upper stretch, rallied inside in the final furlong and closed well but just missed. HOLY HUMOR settled towards the rear of the field, was in tight leaving the backstretch, moved out on the far turn, rallied four wide into the stretch, closed well to loom a threat entering the final furlong but hung and just earned the show. IDA BET YUKON TOO set the pace, vied into the final furlong and gave way grudgingly. WALKWAY was unhurried towards the rear, moved out nearing the furlong marker and finished willingly but reached his best stride too late. WINCHESTER BAY prompted the pace on the outside, chased the leader on the far turn, made a bid at the top of the stretch, battled into the final furlong and gave way. ALBERT W. lingered towards the back of the field, raced four wide on the far turn and lacked the needed response. GENTLEMAN VOLPONI lagged at the rear of the field, came four wide into the stretch and showed little. ATREVIDO BANDITO raced four wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, came up empty while three wide on the far turn and dropped out. (Rail at 0 Feet)
