Footnotes

MAGGIES SNOWMAN raced just off the pace while off the rail, chased on the turn, shifted four wide near the quarter-pole, rallied to the lead passing the furlong marker and inched clear under strong urging. BALDACCI chased the pace, made a bid leaving the backstretch, vied two to three wide on the turn, battled with the winner into the final sixteenth and was outfinished while clear for the place. JUST EXPECTATIONS bumped with NOBEL LEX entering the main track, chased the pace, made a bid near the three-eighths pole, vied three to four wide on the turn and tired while just able to get the show. SHADOW'S BABY raced towards the rear while under some urging, was in tight near the three-eighths pole, drifted out at the top of the stretch and just missed the show. ICY BLIZZARD settled off the pace, steadied some near the three-eighths pole, went three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. NOBEL LEX bumped with JUST EXPECTATIONS entering the main track, chased the pace, raced four to five wide on the turn and weakened. MEANT TO BE HERE was urged along on the outside, went three then four wide early on the turn, moved to five wide near the quarter-pole and was no factor. WITT'S ROAD moved up after the start, pressed the pace, dropped back near the seven-sixteenths pole, raced inside on the turn and faded. ABBIE'S ON FIRE set the pace, lost the lead on the turn and also faded.
