Footnotes

TOUCHED BY FAITH settled in third position, moved closer on the far turn, made a bid between rivals at the top of the stretch, brushed with a rival while doing so, battled between horses in the final furlong and gamely prevailed under strong urging. SWEETSFORTHESWEET settled off the pace, moved closer while three to four wide on the far turn, came six wide into the stretch, made a bid near the eighth-pole, battled outside in the final furlong and missed. STICKER PATCH CAT lagged at the rear of the field while on the inside, moved closer on the far turn, surged to the lead in upper stretch, battled with the top two in the final furlong and also missed. ALLURE went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved closer while four to five wide on the far turn, lacked room behind rivals near the quarter-pole, moved out in upper stretch and finished fast but was too late. B G WANT ME BACK settled towards the rear, saved ground on the far turn and improved position along the rail. LA CANNE CAN saved ground on the initial turn, settled off the pace, moved closer while three then four wide on the far turn, came seven wide into the stretch, held a good striking position into the final furlong but lacked the needed

kick. BIANAMAZED went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, went two to three wide on the far turn, swung five wide into the stretch and also lacked the needed kick. WHERE'STHEDOVE settled off the pace, went two to three wide on the far turn, came four wide into the stretch, moved to the outside and lacked the needed response. COUSHATA LADY raced three wide on the first turn, settled on the outside and failed to threaten. LADY JULIANA contested the pace on the inside, dropped back inside the five-eighths pole, tracked the leader, raced inside on the far turn and came up empty. CRIMSON CABARET raced three to four wide on the first turn, moved to a clear lead inside the five-eighths pole, vied two to three wide on the far turn, brushed with a rival at the top of the stretch and gave way. JOSEPH COUNTDOWN went three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, went four to five wide early on the far turn, moved to six wide near the quarter-pole and failed to respond. (Rail at 0 Feet)
