OUT OUR WAY dueled on the outside, inched clear nearing the five-sixteenths marker and held gamely under steady urging. PALTU dueled on the inside, dropped back then shifted off the rail near the five-sixteenths marker, chased the winner into the final furlong and was only second best. MEET DR MIKE lugged in at the start, was never far back, steadied leaving the backstretch, advanced between rivals midway through the turn, held a good striking position while three wide into the stretch, maintained that position into the final furlong then weakened and was just able to hold the show. MAJESTIC DATE showed good speed between rivals, chased while three wide early on the turn, was forced four wide near the five-sixteenths marker, dropped back to three wide passing the quarter-pole and lacked the needed response while just missing the show. SINGLE SOX was well placed on the inside, steadied approaching the five-sixteenths marker, saved ground into the stretch and came up empty. WILD PROSPECTOR lacked early speed on the outside, raced three wide on the turn and failed to threaten. FAST FASHION was shut-off at the start, advanced a bit while ridden along, raced three wide on the turn and never reached contention. JOINT SESSION was void of speed, raced three wide on the turn and showed little. OPEN TIL MIDNIGHT was forced in at the start, saved ground while well off the pace and was no factor. MR NAEVUS dropped well behind the field, saved ground on the turn and trailed throughout.
