STAKES Ouija Board Distaff H. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred
 (PLUS UP TO \$15,750 Open ATB) FOR FILLIES AND MARES, THREE YEARS OLD AND UPWARD. No nomination fee. \$1,500 to pass the entry box and an additional \$1,500 to start with \$200,000 guaranteed of which \$120,000 to the owner of the winner, \$40,000 to second, \$22,000 to third, \$12,000 to fourth and \$6,000 to fifth. Weights: Sunday, May 18, 2008. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. High weights preferred. The field will be limited to twelve starters. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. A suitable award will be presented to the winning owner. Nominations closed Thursday, May 15, 2008 with 34 nominations. (If Deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the Turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile.)

Footnotes

BROWNIE POINTS was unhurried near the back of the field, advanced four wide on the far turn, shifted six wide near the quarter-pole, rallied in upper stretch, closed strongly to get the lead near the sixteenth-pole then moved clear under right hand urging. TEARS I CRY pressed the pace, vied outside on the far turn, inched clear entering the stretch, remained clear into the final furlong, drifted out outside the sixteenth-pole and was overtaken while able to hold the place. COSTUME (GB) lugged in passing the wire the first time then bumped multiple times with CANDY BALL, went three wide on the first turn, was reserved in the middle of the field, raced three wide on the far turn, shifted five wide and was roused near the quarter-pole, rallied into the final furlong, was shut-off nearing the sixteenth-pole, altered course to the outside and finished willingly but missed the place. CANDY BALL bumped multiple times with COSTUME (GB) before the first turn, raced three wide on that turn, settled towards the front of the field, went three then four wide on the far turn, held a good striking position into the final furlong but lacked the needed kick and just missed the show. EMMA GRACE settled in the middle of the field, shifted over heels leaving the far turn and finished willingly but also lacked the needed kick. FOREST MELODY broke a bit awkwardly, was well placed just off the pace, came under a ride on the far turn, dropped in at the top of the stretch and lacked the needed response. MY THREE SISTERS lingered towards the rear of the field, saved ground on both turns and failed to rally. SUPER FREAKY bobbed at the start and was off slow, was reserved near the back of the field, shifted seven wide near the quarter-pole, held a good striking position into the final furlong but also lacked the needed response. BARBETTE settled towards the back of the field, came three wide into the stretch and failed to rally. BUDDHA LADY raced three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased three wide on the far turn and came up empty. ELLIECAT set the pace through solid fractions, dropped out near the quarter-pole and faded.
