SWINGIN CAT settled while off the rail, shifted three wide near the quarter-pole, rallied on the outside and closed well to get up late. SMOKE'N AL crossed over before the first turn, set the clear pace on the inside, battled gamely in the stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was denied. BAG GATE went three to four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, raced three to four wide early on the far turn, moved to five wide near the quarter-pole and finished willingly for the show. COMPENSATION settled off the pace while off the inside, dropped to the rail nearing the quarter-pole, moved out in upper stretch, gained ground through traffic in the final furlong and just missed the show. RIKKI TIKKI TAVI saved ground on the first turn, settled towards the rear of the field, was urged along while off the rail on the far turn and finished with good energy but missed the minor awards. RED HOT QUEST went three then four wide on the first turn, settled in the middle of the field, was urged along while three then four wide on the far turn and also finished willingly. POLKA JOKE tracked the pace while off the rail, chased on the far turn, made a bid near the furlong marker but was outfinished. STOP TALKING was caught five wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, chased three to four wide on the far turn, loomed a threat into the final furlong but was also outfinished. ZAP A PRINCE had a shoe repaired in the paddock, went three wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, went three wide early on the far turn then shifted five wide,

moved to six wide near the quarter-pole and gained ground but failed to menace. FURIA PERSONAL raced three wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased three then two wide on the far turn and tired. WILD SERVE went four wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, chased inside on the far turn and lacked the needed response. RICH MONARCHOS settled on the inside, saved ground on both turns and faded. (Rail at 0 Feet)
