Footnotes

CONGAREE bobbled at the start, was sent straight to the lead, set the pace with a clear advantage into the final turn, was challenged near the five-sixteenth pole, continued with a short lead into upper stretch, was boldly challenged by PRINCE IROQUOIS passing the furlong marker, but responded very well and kicked clear again under left hand urging. PRINCE IROQUOIS settled while saving ground, ranged up on the final turn while continuing to save ground, angled out at the top of the stretch, loomed very boldly passing the eighth pole, but was turned away and was no match for the winner late. MERCENARY was allowed to settle into stride, angled seven wide entering the stretch, and finished well to get the show. MR. JOHN bobbled slightly at the start, was forwardly placed down the backstretch, dropped back on the turn, came again in upper stretch, bumped with REBA'S GOLD late, and finished willingly. REBA'S GOLD was unhurried in the front half of the field, ranged up four wide on the final turn to contest the lead, drifted five wide entering the stretch, had nothing left in the final furlong, and bumped with MR. JOHN late while weakening. FREEDOM CREST raced four wide on the first turn, tracked the pace down the backstretch, moved up to challenge CONGAREE on the final turn, but came up empty in the stretch and weakened. COMPENDIUM bumped with L.A. SPIDER LEGS at the start, raced in mid pack, angled five wide entering the stretch, and went evenly. L. A. SPIDER LEGS bumped with COMPENDIUM at the start, raced five wide on the first turn, settled up close to the pace, made a bid between rivals on the final turn, but failed to sustain that bid, and faded in the stretch. VALHOL raced five wide on the first turn, and never reached contention. LIGHTS ON BROADWAY broke in slightly at the

start, raced four wide on both turns, and failed to threaten. REMINGTON ROCK crossed over entering the first turn, trailed the field, raced five wide on the final turn, and was outrun. UNRULLAH BULL settled towards the rear, raced five wide entering the backstretch, went five wide on the final turn, moved to six wide entering the stretch, and was no factor.
