MAGIC WEAPON was bumped at the start, dueled between rivals then outside of CHRISTY MARIE on the turn, kicked clear in upper stretch, and held well under strong right hand urging. HADENOUGH was away alertly at the start, chased the pace while three wide, drifted five wide leaving the turn, and was only second best. NICHOLELLA raced near the middle of the field, went three wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch, and earned the show while no match for the top two. CHRISTY MARIE broke outward and bumped MAGIC WEAPON, dueled on the inside, vied into the stretch, and faded. I KNOW YOU raced towards the rear of the field, saved ground on the turn, came off the rail entering the stretch, and showed little. PREJUZGADA (ARG) saved ground on the turn, and was always outrun. SILVER GYPSY was off a half-step slow, raced four wide on the turn, and was outrun.
