Footnotes

ICY KITTEN contested the early pace on the inside then was rated just behind the leader, moved out with a half-mile to run, made a bid on the far turn, was set down in upper stretch, inched clear into the final furlong and was all out to last under strong urging. MISS PEPPER raced inside on the first turn, was unhurried at the back of the field, moved closer on the far turn, waited off heels at the top of the stretch, rallied along the rail shortly thereafter, closed strongly in the final furlong and just missed. KAYLA DO settled on the inside, moved closer near the seven-sixteenths pole, waited behind a rival passing the quarter-pole, was put to a drive in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick while able to garner the show. QUEEN LA BELLA raced off the rail on the first turn, was urged along on the backstretch, went three wide on the far turn, moved out in upper stretch and finished willingly. KUTTER CREEK was taken in hand early, raced two to three wide on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, moved closer while three wide on the far turn, held a good striking position in upper stretch but lacked the needed response. SMOOTH SEA raced four then three wide on the first turn, tracked the pace on the outside, chased four wide on the far turn and tired. COSMIC BAKER raced three then two wide on the first turn, set the pace through moderate fractions, lost the lead on the far turn, battled into the final furlong and gave way. DESERT BIRD settled off the pace, dropped back while inside on the far turn, moved out near the quarter-pole, swung five wide into the stretch and failed to threaten. (Rail at 0 Feet)
