### Footnotes

B'WANAGOLDMINE settled while off the rail, waited on the far turn, continued to wait while blocked near the three-sixteenths pole, shifted out for room, rallied on the outside and closed strongly to win going away. BALTIMORE BOB contested the pace on the outside, inched clear leaving the backstretch, was asked in upper stretch, led into the final furlong and was outfinished while able to get the place. I NEED A BALEOUT saved ground on the first turn, was rated off the pace, ranged up on the far turn, made a bid near the quarter-pole, battled with BALTIMORE BOB into the final furlong and was also outfinished while clear for the show. KIPSANDY saved ground on the first turn, settled outside on the backstretch, was asked near the three-eighths pole, went three wide on the far turn and weakened. CLUB TEJANO lagged at the rear while saving ground, shifted three wide in the vicinity of the quarter-pole and failed to threaten. CATRIN contested the pace on the inside, dropped back leaving the backstretch, saved ground through the far turn and gave way. (Rail at 0 Feet)
