KID KIOWA was eager into the first turn then reserved off the pace, raced inside early on the far turn then moved out, came three wide into the stretch, rallied on the outside and closed strongly to get up late. WUBBZY was well rated while setting the pace, responded well when asked for his best in upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was caught. NORTH OF ALASKA raced inside on the first turn, tracked the pace, chased on the far turn, pursued the leader in the stretch and lacked the needed kick while able to get the show. QUIET COMMAND was eager into the first turn, raced inside on that turn, was rated off the pace, moved closer while inside on the far turn, shifted out in upper stretch and also lacked the needed kick. THEZIMMAN lingered well back in the field, saved ground on the far turn and finished willingly along the rail. SPECIAL DURBEE went two to three wide on the first turn, was rated off the pace, went two then three wide on the far turn, moved to four wide near the quarter-pole and lacked the needed response. JETHRO went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, raced four wide on the far turn, drifted out at the top of the stretch and tired. COUGAR'S ARROW went three to four wide on the first turn, was forwardly placed on the outside, chased three on the far turn and also lacked the needed response. RED BIRDS MAGICIAN bumped with THUNDER BRITCHES entering the first turn, saved ground on that turn, settled towards the back, went three then two wide on the far turn and failed to rally. THUNDER BRITCHES was rank early, bumped with RED BIRDS MAGICIAN entering the first turn, was reserved towards the back, went four to five wide on the far turn and failed to respond. UNDER OATH was fractious in the gate, raced three wide on the first turn, lingered well back in the field, went

four wide on the far turn and was no factor. (Rail at 0 Feet)
