KNOCKIN AROUND was urged along on the outside, advanced five then four wide on the turn, chased BIG ROJO into the final furlong, made a bid near the sixteenth-pole then drew clear under urging. BIG ROJO contested the pace, inched clear leaving the backstretch, raced off the rail on the turn, was put to the whip in upper stretch, tired in the final furlong and was overtaken while clear for the place. NAFISS was ridden along at the rear, went three wide on the turn, swung six wide into the stretch and got up for the show. UP FOR A RODEO bumped with a rival at the start, contested the pace, chased inside on the turn and tired. JONES PLAYER broke in and bumped with a rival, raced just off the heels of the leaders, was taken up near the three-eighths pole then again near the quarter-pole, came three wide into the stretch and lacked the needed response. ONE SMILE chased the pace, raced four wide on the turn, came five wide into the stretch and weakened. WITT'S MIDWAY bumped with rivals at the start, contested the pace, chased on the turn and came up empty. EXPRESSLY ITRON showed good speed, dropped back off heels near the half-mile pole, went three wide on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and capitulated.
