MY MAX REGAL broke out and bumped with a rival, went two then three wide on the first turn, settled off the pace, moved closer near the seven-sixteenths pole, advanced four wide to make a bid on the far turn, battled with BOURBONELLA in upper stretch and drew clear under strong urging. EXTRAVAGANCE settled off the pace, was urged along on the far turn and finished willingly for the place. BLUE SUE moved in early, saved ground on the first turn, settled towards the rear, moved closer while inside on the far turn, waited off heels passing the quarter-pole, came through along the rail in upper stretch, moved out near the furlong marker and finished willingly for the show. PARQUETERIE saved ground on the first turn, settled off the pace, dropped back while behind horses early on the far turn, came out three wide in the process, shifted six wide into the stretch and improved position. JADE'S KITTY raced off the rail on the first turn, lingered towards the rear, moved closer on the far turn, was caught in traffic passing the quarter-pole then steadied while blocked, came six wide into the stretch and finished with late energy. BOURBONELLA tracked the pace on the inside, took the lead passing the five-sixteenths pole, battled

with the winner in upper stretch and gave way. B'S BABY GIRL was bumped at the start, went three wide on the first turn, settled towards the front, raced two to three wide on the far turn, was in traffic near the quarter-pole and came up empty. ZODEVA settled near the middle of the field, went three to four wide on the far turn and failed to rally. FLASHY BANGLES went four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, moved closer late on the backstretch, made a bid while three to four wide on the far turn, came five wide into the stretch and capitulated. HELLO HELLO HALO went three to four wide on the first turn, settled on the outside, was urged along while four to five wide on the far turn and failed to threaten. BANT AMMI broke a bit slow, was rank through the first turn and showed little. TICKET TO HEAVEN set the clear pace while off the rail, lost the lead at the five-sixteenths pole, came three wide into the stretch and faded. (Rail at 0 Feet)
