Footnotes

MORE THAN THAT settled nicely in third position, went four then five wide on the turn, was asked at the top of the stretch, rallied to the lead outside the furlong marker and drew away under strong urging. WITT'S EXPECTATION set the pace, extended the advantage late on the backstretch, controlled the action while two to three wide on the turn, lost the lead in upper stretch and proved on match while clear for the place. JOHNLOUISCLASSICAL chased the pace on the outside, went three to four wide on the turn and also proved no match for the winner but finished with good courage to just miss the place. COMPLETELY WRIGHT broke in and was last away, raced in the middle of the field while urged along, saved ground on the turn and failed to threaten. LASH'S LOVER settled towards the rear, raced inside on the turn and was no factor. DULCE FINA was coaxed along on the outside, raced four wide on the turn and failed to respond. PRANCY FANCY dropped back then settled at the rear, fell well behind the field and showed little.
